II. RATIONALE

Pamanang Kuwerdas Oriental Mindoro (PKOM) is a provincial cultural group that recognizes the local communities as key partners and co-investors in Oriental Mindoro's history, arts and culture. PKOM aims in supporting arts and culture in their communities through: (1) Supporting and implementing history, arts and cultural programs, activities and events; (2) Providing funding to local history, arts and cultural practitioners and organizations; (3) Establishing strong partnership with local, national and international history, culture and arts related agencies; (4) Providing employment for arts and cultural workers; (5) Cultural planning for increased livelihood ability and economic growth; (6) Encouraging establishments of local cultural facilities such as schools, colleges, universities, public libraries, local museums, galleries and performing arts centers.

The Office of the Extension Services of MCC desires to partner and collaborate thru a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with MinSU in supporting PKOM advocacies which presently promotes the role and value of arts, culture and heritage as key drivers of diverse and inclusive communities and strong regions and invests in local arts and cultural priorities, as determined by local communities, and formulate programs to suit the needs of local communities.

This project is being proposed because we believe that educating the next generation of Mindoreños is the best avenue in promoting, inculcating and preserving Oriental Mindoro's rich cultural heritage. As the old saying goes, "Ang hindi lumigon sa pinanggalingan ay hindi makararating sa kanyang paroroonan" which means that anybody who does not know where he came from, will never reach his/her destination.

III. OBJECTIVES

The main objective of this extension project is to establish a collaborative effort that will be called MinSU-PKOM which will support arts and cultural activities.

Specifically, it aims to:

- (1) Contribute the value of local cultural heritage to local communities;



(2) Engage local communities in preserving the rich cultural heritage of the past;

(3) Deliver local priorities that will assist in promoting the native products made by our Mangyan brothers; and,

(4) Deliver priorities including encouraging safe and inclusive communities, building regions, stimulating economic growth, innovation and increasing workforce participation.

MinSU-PKOM also aims to support an advocacy of selected members of MinSU community to initiate a research study on creating a college course that will focus on the History of the Province of Oriental Mindoro including its rich cultural heritage and early inhabitants, specifically the Mangyan Tribes, in collaboration with Oriental Mindoro Council for History, Culture and the Arts led by our very own local historian, Mr. Florante D. Villarica. It also supports a proposed research study on starting a music lesson that will eventually paved the way of enhancing the music and arts abilities of young MinSU students, faculty members and employees who are musically gifted.

IV. PROJECT COMPONENTS

Planning Stage:

Cultural Activities are being proposed for the whole year to be held at the different agencies/places in Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro which will showcase the skills and talents of the participants. The facilitators and resource speakers will be provided by PKOM.

Project Implementation Stage:

The implementation of this extension project activity will highlight cultural presentation of the participants.

Monitoring and Evaluation Stage:

This kind of activity will pave the way for the participants to strengthen their passion to preserve the rich cultural heritage of our province thru history, music and arts. The participants will be empowered to become passionate in encouraging other young generations of Mindoreños to embrace and preserve our cultural heritage instead of idolizing other cultural practices of foreign countries. Regular meeting/practice will be held twice a month. Assessment of the performance will also be done every last month of the year.

Training Management

The Office of the Extension Services of MCC and PKOM shall provide general supervision and oversight of the training workshop with logistical assistance from the University Administration. Training workshop expenses will come from the financial grant of the PKOM.
