**Theme: “Water Is Food Water Is Life, Leave No One Behind”
October 31, 2023**

I.Objectives

- Captures the significance of water as a source of sustenance and its role in ensuring food security.
- Aims to create awareness among students on the critical role of water for life on earth and water as the foundation of our food.

II. Narrative Report

This event aims to create awareness among students on the critical role of water for life on earth and water as the foundation of our food. For the second time, the Ambassadors Organization decided to celebrate World Food Day with the theme: “Water is Food Water Is Life Leave no One Behind” on the 31st day of October 2023. The Ambassadors Officer, Ms. Joyce Campang, organized the program with the guidance of the adviser, Ms. Mary Suleide P. Melendrez, and the program chairperson of the Ambassadors Organization, Mr. Zernan R. Maling. The event’s participants were the members of the Ambassadors from the first year to the fourth year. The Ambassadors Organization were glad they participated wholeheartedly in making these simple programs happen, especially in different contests such as poster-making, infographic contest, and slogan-making contest.

The contest was from 8:30 am until 10:30 am. To organize the game, each officer is assigned to which contest they facilitate. The facilitator for the infographic contest is Mr. Leonard Naling. In poster making, the officer assigned to facilitate was Ms. Tricia Lomibao, while in the slogan contest, the assigned officer to facilitate was Ms. Cristella Montalban. CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. The contest is **open to all BSHM students** of MinSU Bongabong campus. **One participant per section.**
2. Each participant should **submit ONE entry per section.**
3. The poster **must illustrate, interpret and emphasize** the theme.
4. All artworks must be done on the spot and must be **completed within the allotted time of 1 hour.**
5. The poster must be done in **free hand.**
6. All entries must be **pre-numbered.** No other identifying marks will be allowed to appear in the artworks.
7. The artist **will be held accountable to any issues** that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.
8. The following materials should be brought by the contestant: oil pastel, marker, eraser, pencil, and except of 1/8 illustration board that is provided by the facilitator.
