MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement made and executed this _____ day of 2022 at _____ by and between:

The **MINDORO STATE UNIVERSITY**, a tertiary educational institution established under existing Philippine law, with the main campus located at Alcate, Victoria, Oriental Mindoro, represented in this Agreement by **DR. LEVY B. ARAGO JR.**, University President, hereafter referred to as the **MinSU**;

-and-

The **MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO**, a local government unit with office address at Victoria, Oriental Mindoro, represented by **Mayor ERNILO C. VILLAS**, hereafter referred to as the **LGU-BULALACAO**.

RECITALS:

- A. MinSU, as an institution of learning, proactively responds to the challenge of delivering quality education amidst the COVID-19 pandemic through innovative solutions to optimize educational endeavors. These include adopting flexible learning wherein the University maximizes its resources to upgrade its IT infrastructure, strengthen its technological support, and establish flexibility in addressing various learners' type and connectivity. Recognizing the significant role of the LGUs in providing accessibility of learning to students in the community, MinSU seeks partnership in the implementation of its project titled "We CONNECT as One: MinSU and LGU Partnership for Flexible Learning.
- B. LGU-Bulalacao recognizes the role of education in uplifting the lives of its constituents, particularly the contribution of the youth in community development, hence, the need to provide mechanisms and opportunities that are within reach. Thus, it supports the partnership with MinSU in delivering learning opportunities through flexible learning to make education accessible, especially during this time of COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto have agreed, as follows:

A. Term

This Agreement shall take effect upon execution hereof and shall be valid for _____ from the date of execution, subject to formal renewals.

B. Duties and Responsibilities of MinSU

1. Provide ICT equipment such as computers, internet routers, printers, and internet connectivity to be used in flexible learning;
2. Supervise, oversee and facilitate the delivery of flexible learning activities;
3. Prepare a coordinated student, schedule of learning activities and access to learning materials;
4. Assign faculty members and personnel tasked to facilitate learning delivery;
5. Assume the responsibility for the expenses for printing and distribution of learning materials;
6. Responsible for the upkeep, maintenance of cleanliness, and orderliness of the learning facility, place or venue;
7. Ensure observance of minimum health protocols and safety against COVID-19 pandemic;

8. Undertake a schedule onsite visit every 2nd Tuesday of the month unless there is a necessity to conduct a special visit for project monitoring and evaluation.

C. Duties and Responsibilities of LGU-Bulalacao

1. Provide the facility, venue or space to be used as temporary learning station of MinSU, such as, but not limited to:

- 1.1 gymnasium, social hall, activity center, or other places where it is conducive for learning
- 1.2 office space or room for the safekeeping of documents and other office equipment
- 1.3 power for internet and printing equipment
- 1.4 water for sanitary, health, and safety requirement
- 1.5 other facilities for the necessity of MinSU personnel and students during the onsite visit.

2. Assign representative/s to assist MinSU personnel in performing the following activities:

- 2.1 facilitate in the preparation of learning site during the visit;
- 2.2 coordinate among the units or departments;
- 2.3 maintain the orderliness and cleanliness of the place;
- 2.4 supervise and implement safety protocols for the COVID-19 pandemic;
- 2.5 received documents of the students after the schedule date in the designated pick-up and distribution point.

D. Amendments

Amendment to any provision of this agreement shall not valid unless it is in writing and signed by the parties.

E. Severability

Any provision of this agreement that is rendered invalid not affect the validity of the remainder of this Agreement.

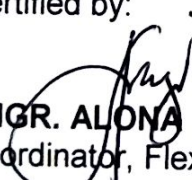

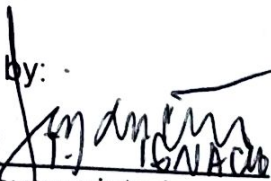

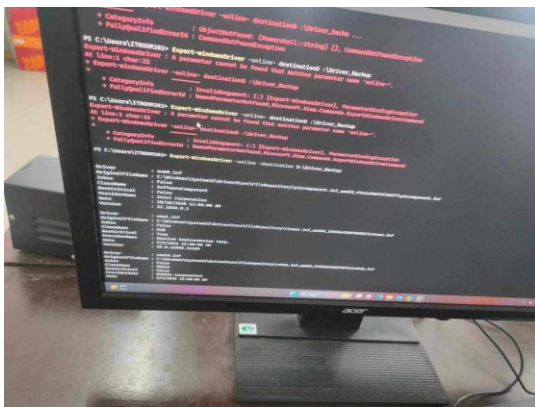
COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAM
