

ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

SECTION 1. COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- 1.1. General Education Curriculum. All undergraduate students, regardless of their major, must complete the prescribed General Education Curriculum. This curriculum exposes them to various fields of knowledge and fosters intellectual skills such as critical, analytical, and creative thinking. It aligns with the guidelines set by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) under CMO 20 s. 2013.
- 1.2. Specialization Courses. These courses comprise both mandatory and elective classes within a specific field of study, focusing on theoretical and practical aspects.
- 1.3. Thesis/Capstone/On-the-Job Training/Student Teaching: Both graduate and undergraduate programs require students to submit a research-based thesis relevant to their field of specialization or a technical/narrative report on Field Practice/On-the-Job Training (OJT). In the Teacher Education Program, a 6-unit Student Teaching experience is mandatory.

SECTION 2. GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1. No student shall be denied admission to the University by reason of age, sex, race, and religion.
- 2.2. Admission to the University is subject to the following criteria:
 - a. New Students. Admission is granted through the MinSU Admission Test and applies to the following:
 - i. Graduating Senior High School Students of the school year preceding the academic year opened for admission;
 - ii. Senior High School Graduates from DepEd-recognized high schools (CHED Memorandum Order No. 10, s. 2017) or accredited secondary schools abroad who have not previously enrolled in any academic college course;
 - iii. Passers of the Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT), Alternative Learning System (ALS), or Non-Formal Education Accreditation and
