II. RATIONALE:

An Alternative and Holistic Health Services (AHHS) is being undertaken by a group of volunteer doctors, nurses, medical health workers, lawyers and professionals. Each member of IVMCC took an independent decision to join other volunteers and monitor patients suffering from COVID and its effects with as much virtual CARE as possible. The pandemic may have physically distanced people but IVMCC reaches out its virtual hands to help Covid-affected patients and their loved ones manage healing at home. With the use of online chat threads such as FB messenger, this group of doctors and civilian volunteers are able to teach the patient and families what to monitor and how to address the challenges of their illnesses until full recovery. IVMCC also aims to empower people with basic health information to help ease the fear that Covid-19 had brought. The group is composed of ordinary citizens, mostly with no medical background, from different life stages, walks of life and regions in the Philippines. All united by the common goal of offering support to anyone who needs help in treating Covid-19 and its medical effects in their homes. Blessed with compassionate doctors, loving volunteers, caring nurses and caregivers, advocacy partners, and even prayer warriors, IVMCC continues to share God's love and give hope to our fellow men.

Another volunteer group named the Concerned Doctors and Citizens of the Philippines (CDCPh) wants to help our government safely lift the lockdown so that more lives are saved and more livelihoods are restored. Our taxpayers money are dried up already, we cannot afford extending this lockdown anymore and spend on non-scientific protocols yielding very low to no result. CDCPh have been doing daily research on what would be more efficient and effective in addressing the pandemic and new studies show that the best approach is to include prophylaxis and early treatment protocol. Our government has a 3 pronged approach: barriers, hospitalization, and vaccination. All they want is for our leaders to include cheap effective alternative to treating Covid-19 and be implemented down to the barangay level, available to all Filipinos. They added that we need to have a public discourse about the protocols imposed on our citizens because this concerns our body, our health and our rights. They already appeal to then President Rodrigo Roa Duterte to allow "second opinion" from other doctors who are successful in treating thousands of patients. Many want to be allowed to present how they were able to treat and save significant number of patients. They want to allow the public to question our protocols such as CT (cycle threshold) settings of our RT-PCR machine settings, yielding high false positives. They want to allow them to question DOH data reporting focused on cases and not number of hospitalized which determines whether our healthcare is overwhelmed or not. They want to allow everyone to have a choice regarding vaccination. They also said that we all need to follow science as new studies come out every day. No one agency or individual can claim expertise to a pandemic we have not all experienced before. This is a continuous learning for everyone. And in this time of crisis, everyone needs to be humble and open.

III. OBJECTIVES:

IVMCC and CDCPh desires to collaborate with the Office of the Extension Services of MCC so as to render free medical, dental, optical and feeding activities to target clients specifically those who are less fortunate residents of the barangay which they have chosen.

IV. PROGRAM COMPONENTS:

1. IVMCC & CDCPh volunteers will seek the assistance of the medical team of the MCC University Clinic thru the Office of Extension Services of MCC.
2. IVMCC, CDCPh, & MCC Team will organize the flow of the activities during the medical mission.
3. IVMCC, CDCPh, & MCC Team will request the presence of the Barangay Police Action Team (BPAT) of the selected barangays with support group from Calapan City Police Station (CPS)
