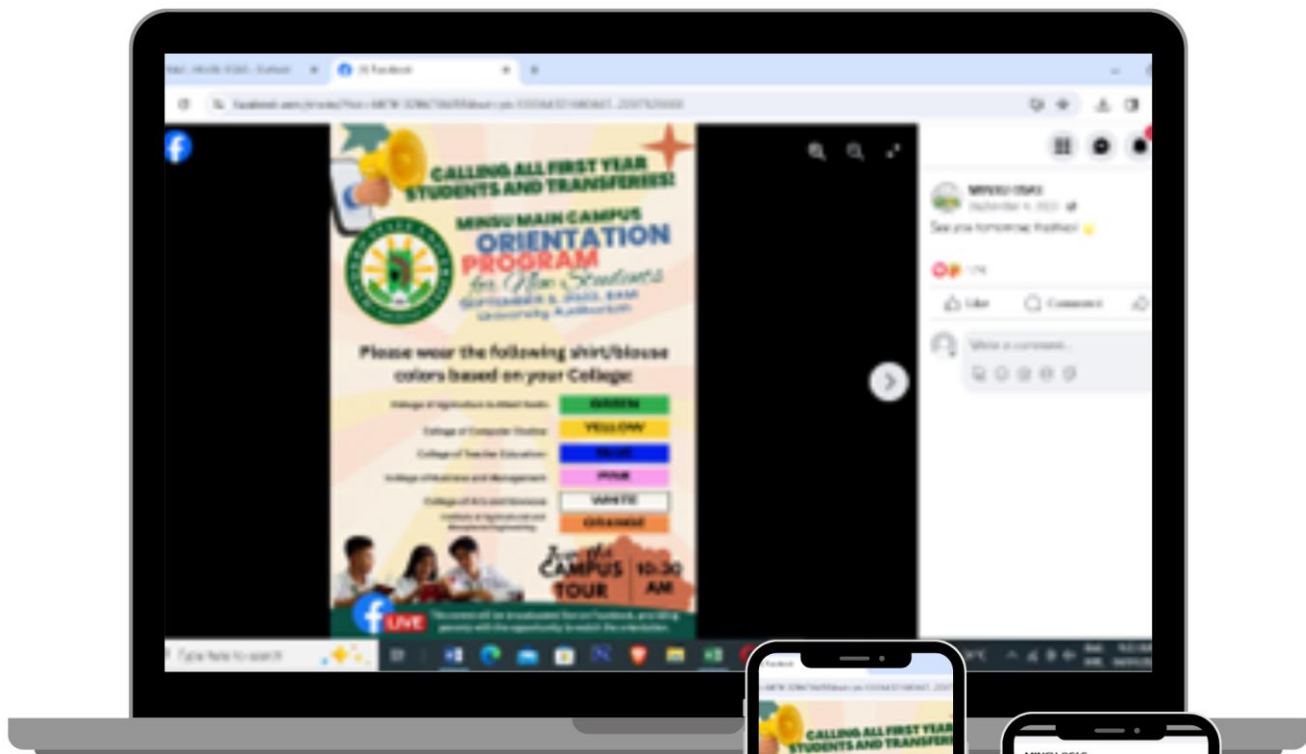
Information & Orientation Services

Key Components:

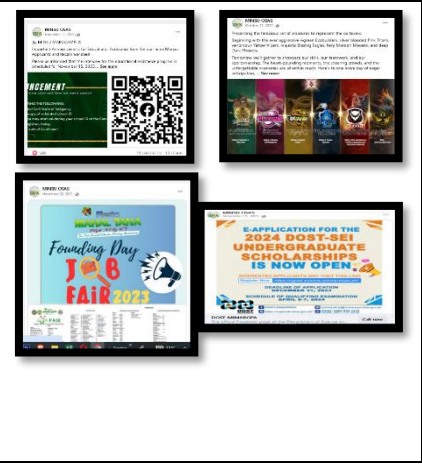

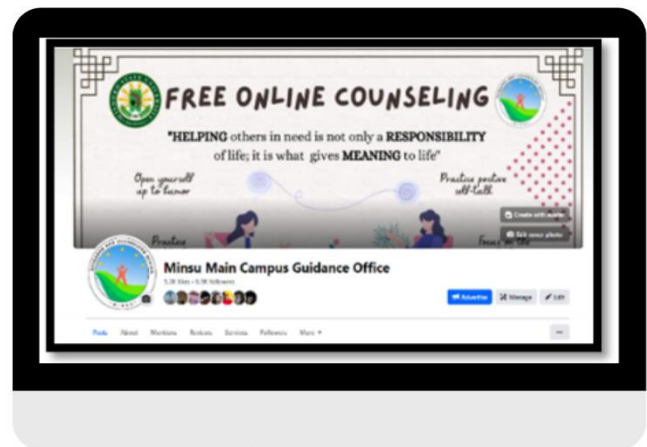
Guidance and Counseling Services

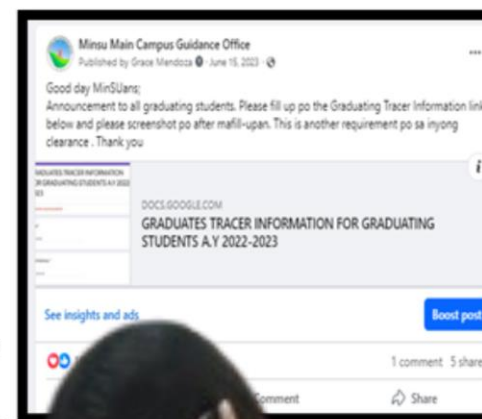
Career Information Guidance: The provision of career guidance remained a priority in 2023. Through targeted sessions and resources, students were empowered to make informed decisions about their future career paths. Labor Education for Graduating Students (LEGS): As part of our commitment to holistic student development, the Guidance and Counselling Services conducted the Labor Education for Graduating Students (LEGS). This comprehensive initiative allowed us to assess the post-graduation experiences of our alumni, ensuring continuous improvement in our educational offerings



Individual and Group Counseling Sessions: Responding to the evolving needs and concerns of students, the Guidance and Counselling Services conducted individual and group counseling sessions. The primary objective was to assist students in understanding themselves and their environment, promoting personal and social adjustment, enhancing career readiness, and improving overall academic performance.



Psychological Assessments: The administration of the 16 PF Psychological Test to pre-internship and graduating college students, along with the RIASEC Test for Grade 10 students, aimed to provide valuable insights into personality traits and career preferences. Collaborative Engagement: Throughout the year, collaborative efforts were made through meetings with Admissions Office to make sure that admission processes of the university are fairly conducted and that targets are met specifically the conduct of admission examinations in the three campuses.

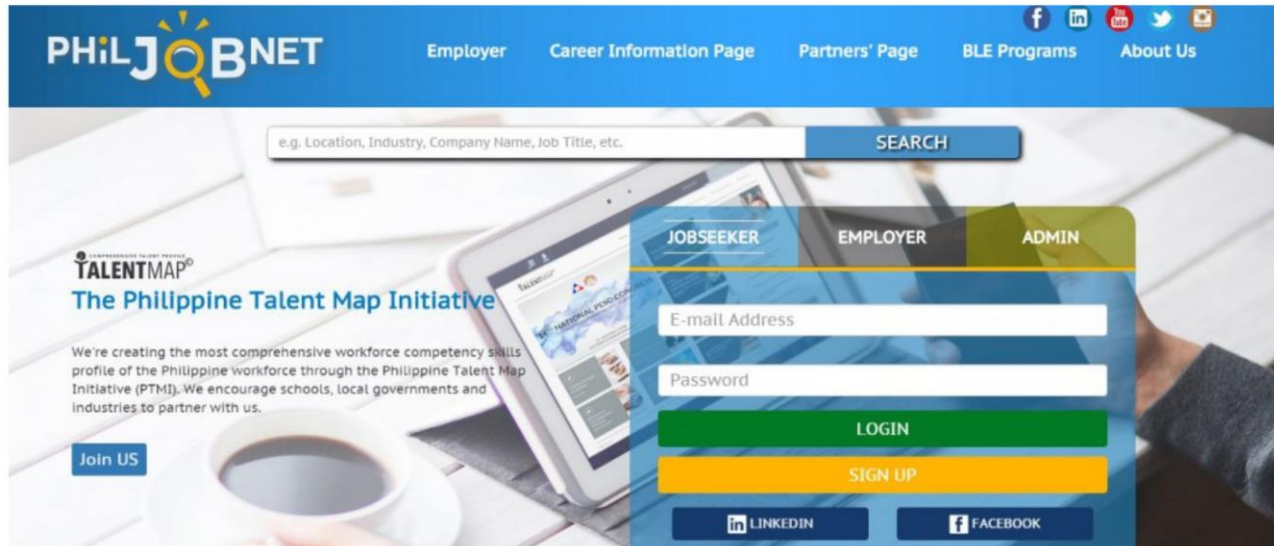
Bridging the Gap between Aspiring Graduates and Potential Employers:
